

INFORMATION FOR NATIONAL JUNIOR TENNIS LEAGUE TOURNAMENT PLAYERS

ENTRIES

1. Entry deadline is the Wednesday before the tournament. If in question, call or Fax the entry to the host club listed on the entry form. You may also register on-line at: psptennis.com. Click on “Juniors”, “N.J.T.L.”, “On-line Entry Form.” All fields must be filled in.
2. A \$10.00 entry fee per player is charged for the event. Sponsorships are available through the N.J.T.L.
3. Players 12-18 yr. ranked in the top 100 or those 10 & under ranked in the top 50 by SCTA must play in a higher age division.
4. Players MUST call the host club between 8 A.M. and 12:00 P.M. the Friday before the tournament for the time of their first match.
5. Due to the limited number of available courts and large number of entries, players may enter one division only.
6. Requests for certain match times may be accommodated ONLY if it does not inconvenience other players or the host club and the host pro has been notified in advance.
7. Players must commit to completing the tournament during regularly scheduled time of play.
8. **CALL THE HOST CLUB IF UNABLE TO REPORT FOR YOUR SCHEDULED MATCH!**

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. 8 game pro set (first to 8, must win by 2, i.e. 9-7.) Tiebreaker at 8-8 (must win by 2, i.e. 10-8)
2. A first match loss moves the player to the Consolation Round.
3. A new can of balls will be provided for each match. Used balls should be returned at the end of each match.
4. Medals are awarded: Gold-1st place and Silver-2nd place in the Winners bracket
: A can of new balls for the Consolation Winner and Runner-up

POINTS

Points are awarded as:

- 1 point for entering the tournament
- 2 points for each win in the Winners bracket
- 1 point for each win in the Consolation bracket

Players not showing up for scheduled matches or consolation matches will not be awarded tournament points. ALL MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED AT THE SCHEDULED CLUB AT THE TIME SCHEDULED BY THE HOST PRO.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Players report to the tournament desk 15 minutes before scheduled match time.
2. A default is called 20 min. after scheduled time of play.
3. Report scores to the desk at the end of each match.
4. Disagreements, i.e. line calls or scoring, should be reported to the tournament desk **by one of the players.** Assistance will be provided.
5. Proper behavior and courtesies are expected on the court.
6. Racquet abuse, ball abuse or bad language will result in:
1st offense =warning; 2nd offense =loss of a point; 3rd offense =loss of game;
4th offense =disqualification and loss of the match.
7. Non-players are not permitted on the court during a match.
8. No coaching is permitted during a match.
